Special Instructions for 2020

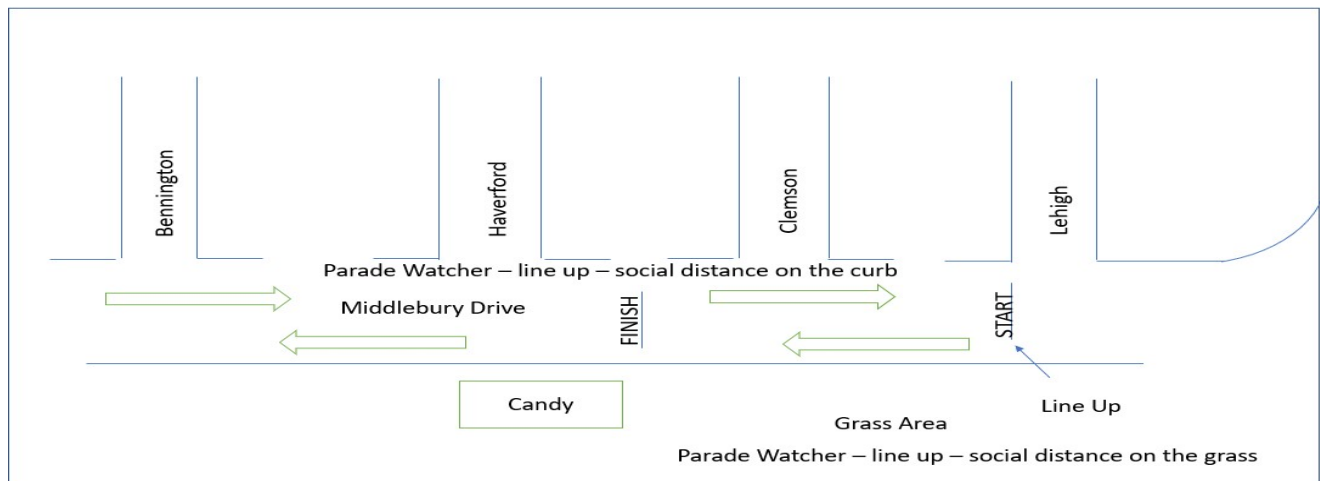
We will need everyone's help in maintaining COVID 19 precautions. The parade will be in one orderly direction with a start line and ending location.

Parade participants will line up at the parade start on the corner of Lehigh and Middlebury and maintain social distance throughout the parade. *Volunteers will mark places to stand at 6 feet intervals prior to the parade.* We ask you use Lehigh to arrive at the parade start or walk on the sidewalk side of Middlebury.

During the parade participants will travel south on Middlebury from Lehigh towards Haverford in one direction maintaining social distance from each other and spectators.

Spectators should find a marked spot on the either side of Middlebury to watch the parade and encourage paraders!

This year candy will be placed in individual bags for participants and families at the end of the parade route on tables. We ask that there be **no candy distribution during the parade**.
