VIP Training in November!

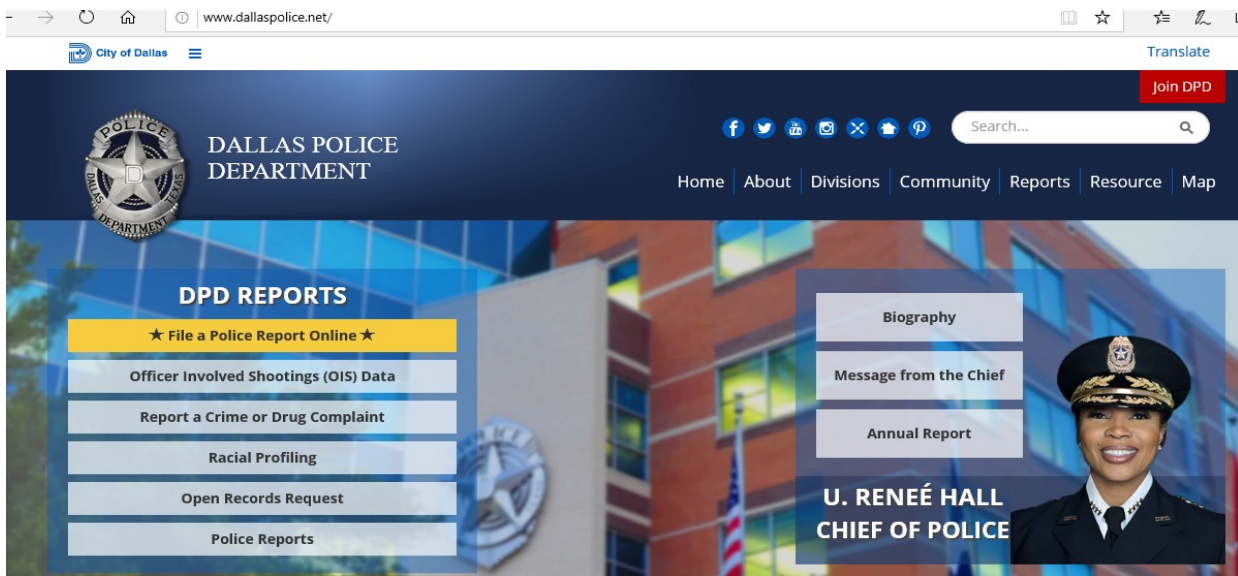

GREENBELT—FRIENDLY REMINDER

SEVERAL RESIDENTS WHO LIVE NEAR MIDDLEBURY HAVE INDICATED TOO MANY PEOPLE ARE NOT ADHERING TO THIS CITY ORDINANCE NEAR THIS GREEN BELT AREA. PLEASE PUT YOUR PET ON A LEASH. ALSO A REMINDER TO THE POOPER SCOOPER ORDINANCE: CHAPTER 7 OF THE DALLAS CITY ORDINANCE, SECTION 7-4.8 REQUIRES THE OWNER, HARBORER, OR A PERSON HAVING CARE, CUSTODY, OR CONTROL OF A DOG, TO REMOVE IN AN IMMEDIATE, AND SANITARY MANNER, ANY FECES CREATED BY THEIR DOG ON PUBLIC PROPERTY, OR ANY PRIVATE PROPERTY NOT OWNED, LEASED, OR CONTROLLED BY THEM. IT FURTHER REQUIRES THOSE INDIVIDUALS TO HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION A DEVICE FOR THE SAFE AND SANITARY REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF DOG FECES. VIOLATORS MAY BE REPORTED TO THE CITY BY CALLING 3-1-1, AND THEY ARE ALSO SUBJECT TO CITATION AND POSSIBLE FINE IF OBSERVED BY CITY OFFICERS AT ANY TIME.
